BROOKSIDE SPORTS

BROOKSIDE SCIENCE

This week in Brookside Science, campers dove into hands-on experiments, exploring surface tension with a colorful "magic milk" activity and getting messy while making their own non-Newtonian slime. The campers wrapped up the week with a fun lesson on buoyancy, watching raisins dance in their cups! Next week, the excitement continues as the campers put their science smarts to the test in a game of Scientific Pictionary and explore the fascinating world of density through more hands-on

experiments.

BROOKSIDE MUSIC

This week in Brookside Music, campers had a blast with "The Purple People Eater," rocking out with rhythm games, jamming in 4/4 time, and creating their own rhythm monster tunes in small groups. Next week, the campers will explore the history of drums in America! They will build their own drums and play along to the folk classic "This Land is Your Land."



BROOKSIDE ART

This week in Brookside Art, campers kicked off the week by making silly portraits inspired by Cubist artist Pablo Picasso using construction paper and oil pastels. Then, the campers learned about the meditative art of Zentangle drawing and learned how to turn them into 3-D paper sculptures after learning about Detroit-based contemporary artist, Charles McGee. Next week, for Patriotic Week, campers will celebrate America's birthday with some fun process-based art like constructing glittery Star-Spangled Mobiles and painting with "Bomb Pops" (frozen tempera paint). TOTS STEM

This week in Tots STEM, our curious campers explored big ideas through fun, hands-on activities! The campers kicked off the week by learning about how to care for our planetcreating their own paper plate Earths and brainstorming ways to keep it clean. Then, the campers stepped into the shoes of young engineers, building marshmallow towers and discovering how to make them strong and tall. The week wrapped up with magnetic magic as they played "Magnetic or Not?", testing everyday objects to see which ones would stick. Next week, the campers will play animal bingo, make magic milk and discover which special items sink and float.

TOTS SCIENCE

This week in Tots Science, campers practiced thinking like scientists by learning key wordshypothesis and experiment. The campers explored opposites with hands-on tests and learned about hot and cold by melting ice to rescue toys. Next week's 4th of July theme brings more excitement as campers make red, white, and blue slime, and launch mini rockets with baking soda and vinegar to learn about chemical reactions.

TOTS ART

This week in Tots Art, the campers engaged in a variety of wacky projects! Campers made their own scratch-off art on paper plates, created wacky figures from doodles, and learned about portraiture by creating crazy funny self-portraits! Next week, campers will create 2-D and 3-D firework crafts!
