Drop Off

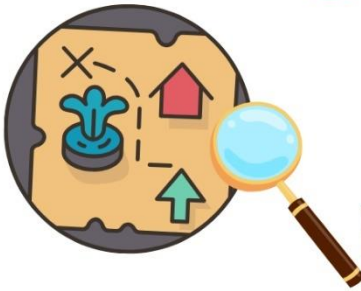


