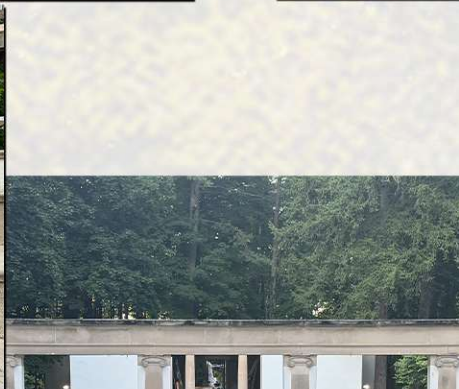

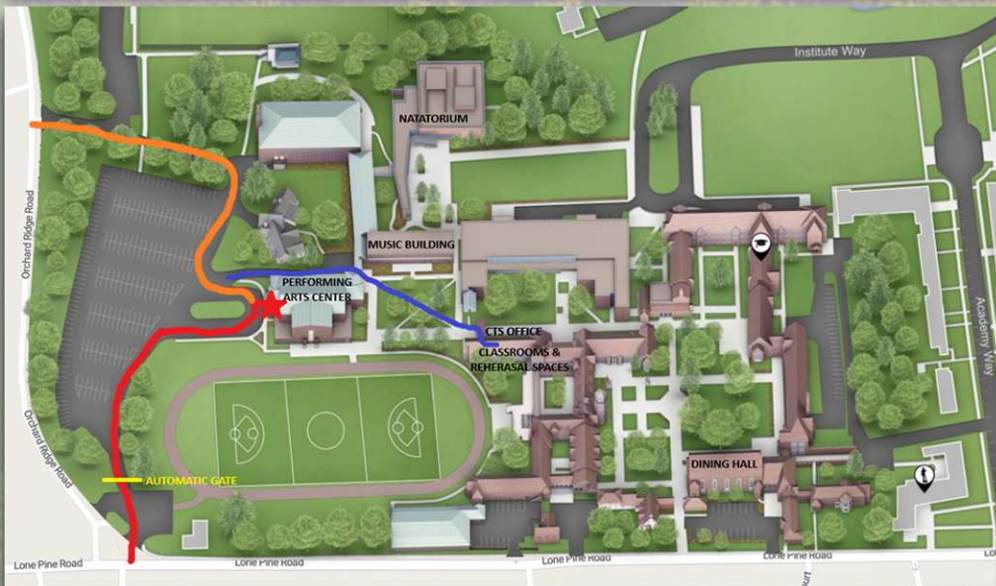
JUNIOR DIVISION

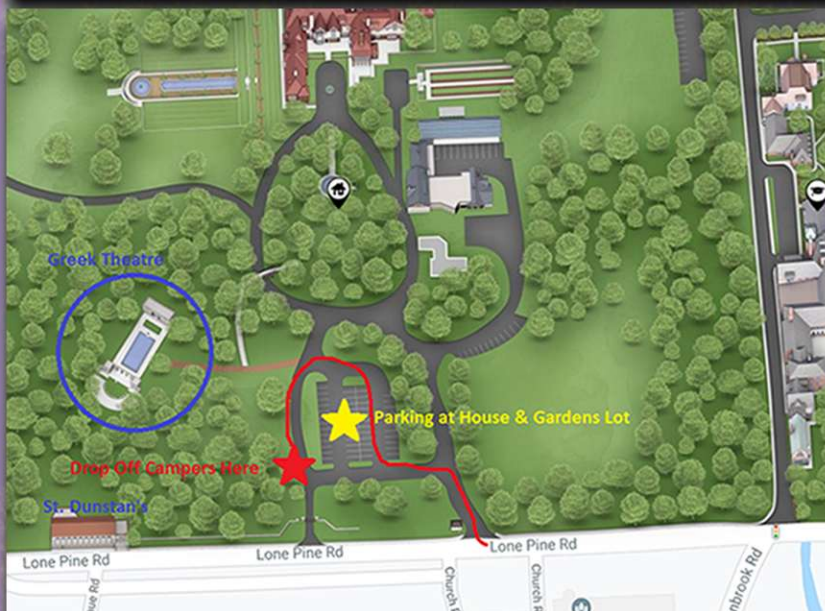
