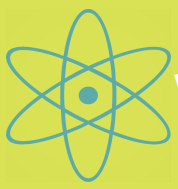
## Drop-off Procedures

STEM Camp drop-off and pick-up are at the Vaughan Road circle drive (1060 Vaughan Road--Boys Middle School. Please see map on page 3).
