## Swim:

#### STEM Camp goes to the Cranbrook Williams Natatorium every <u>Friday</u> to swim.

- We will take a short bus ride to and from the natatorium.
- Campers will change in the locker rooms at the natatorium.
- Campers who choose not to swim will be able to play games or engage in quiet activities on the observation deck with a counselor.
- Campers will be required to pass a swim test to enter the deep end of the pool.



### Come Prepared on Fridays!

Campers who wish to swim should bring their swimsuit and towel in a separate bag labeled with their name.

## Reminders:



Cranbrook is a nut-free campus. Please do not send campers with snacks that may include peanuts or tree-nuts.



Any medications included on registration forms must be with your camper. Please make sure all medications have required documentation and are in-date.



Campers should bring a re-usable water bottle that they can refill throughout the day.



Anyone picking up your camper must be listed in your UltraCamp account and have the authorized pick-up form(attached to this document) visible with your camper's name in their windshield.



Campers should dress appropriately for the weather and to participate in indoor STEM activities (including labs), and outdoor games on the playground.

\*Closed-toe shoes are recommended.



Electronics, toys, or other valuables are not needed at camp and should be left at home!

Personal items that are removed from their bag will be placed in a safe location for campers to retrieve before dismissal.
