

# Cincinnati Nature Center Camp Medication Form

## Cincinnati Nature Center Medication Policies

To bring an Epi-pen, inhaler, or other medication to camp, a parent/guardian must submit a completed Summer Camp Medication Form before leaving the medication with the camper or camp staff.

### Approved medications must be:

- Stored in the original container with the prescription label that includes:
  - Child's full name
  - Current dispensing date within the previous 12 months
  - Exact dosage and direction for use
- Brought to camp at the start of each day and taken home at the end of each day.
- Brought in a Ziploc bag with the camper's name on it.

Camp staff are not permitted to administer medication (except for epi-pens, inhalers, or Benadryl).

- Camp staff are CPR/First Aid Certified.
- Children are required to self-administer medications.
- Camp staff are not responsible for reminding campers to take their medications.
- If a child is not permitted to self-carry, camp staff may hold the medication until the child asks for it.
