


Driving Directions to Camp Cloud Rim



Driving Directions to Camp Cloud Rim

When you arrive at the yellow gate, there is no signage for camp. If camp staff are not present, please contact us at: 435-640-1406 (Ranger), 435-649-8641 (office), or 801-891-8384 (cell). The camp is past the gate about one mile uphill.

FROM SALT LAKE CITY VIA PARK CITY

Drive time is approximately one hour from Salt Lake. GPS = Montage (9100 Marsac Ave, Park City) then skip to number 8.

1. Take I-15 to I-80 East.
2. Take Exit 145 toward Kimball Junction (Park City exit).
3. Turn right onto Highway 224 South. Continue on Highway 224 for about 6 miles to the stoplight at Deer Valley Drive.
4. Turn left (east) onto Deer Valley Drive.
5. Follow Deer Valley Drive through one stoplight to the roundabout.
6. At the roundabout, take Marsac Avenue/Highway 224 South (2nd right).
7. Stay on this road—it will take you up to another roundabout (Montage will be located here).
8. At the Montage you will take the roundabout up the mountain – following the Guardsman Pass brown sign.
9. Continue to follow the Guardsman Pass road to the summit and then start descending down the mountain. While descending, slow down so you don't pass the next intersection.
10. You will come to an intersection with a street sign on left side. You have the options of: turning a hard left, going back down the mountain towards Midway; continuing straight going up the mountain to Guardsman Pass; or taking a slight left onto a gravel road where there is a yellow gate a few yards away.
11. This is the gate for Camp Cloud Rim.

DRIVING SAFETY:

- The speed limit in camp and in the parking lot is 10 mph.
- The mile-long drive from the gate up to camp is a narrow dirt road. Please drive with care and watch for oncoming traffic.
- Passengers need to be seated at all times. Seatbelts **MUST** be worn at all times. Drivers need to watch for pedestrian traffic in the parking lot.

ALTERNATE ROUTE FROM SALT LAKE CITY

VIA BIG COTTONWOOD CANYON
(Closed winters)

NOTE: This route involves a rough, narrow road over Guardsman Pass with steep grades.

1. Take Big Cottonwood Canyon Road toward Brighton.
2. Look for a large sign for Guardsman Pass/Park City (before Brighton Ski Resort); turn left onto Guardsman Pass road. Camp Tuttle is on your right at this intersection.
3. Continue to follow the Guardsman Pass road to the summit and then start descending down the mountain. While descending, slow down so you don't pass the next intersection.
4. You will come to an intersection. You have the options of: turning a slight right, going back down the mountain towards Midway; continuing straight going up the mountain to Park City; or taking a hard right onto a gravel road where there is a yellow gate a few yards away.
5. This is the gate for Camp Cloud Rim.

FROM TREFOIL RANCH

Via Midway (steeper climb up the mountain)
(Closed winters)

1. Drive from camp back down to Vivian Park.
2. Take a right onto Hwy 189, driving up Provo Canyon.
3. After 11.7 miles, turn left onto UT 113, entering Midway.
4. After 4 miles, turn left onto Main Street (UT 224).
5. Take 2nd right on to N 200 W (UT 224).
6. Take 1st right on to Pine Canyon Rd (UT 224).
7. Continue past Wasatch Mountain State Park on Pine Canyon Rd until you get to an intersection with a street sign on right side. You have the options of: turning a hard right, going back up the mountain towards Park City; taking a slight right going up the mountain to Guardsman Pass; or taking a slight left onto a gravel road where there is a yellow gate a few yards away.
8. This is the gate for Camp Cloud Rim.

FROM TREFOIL RANCH

Via Heber and Park City

1. Drive up Provo Canyon Hwy 189 to Heber.
2. Take Hwy 40 heading north.
3. Take Exit 4 Hwy 248 towards Park City. You will come into Park City on Kearns Boulevard.
4. Turn left (north) on Bonanza Drive.
5. At the light turn left (east) onto Deer Valley Drive.
6. Follow Deer Valley Drive through one stoplight to the roundabout.
7. At the roundabout, take Marsac Avenue/Highway 224 South (2nd right).
8. Stay on this road—it will take you up to another roundabout (Montage will be located here).
9. At the Montage you will take the roundabout up the mountain – following the Guardsman Pass brown sign.
10. Continue to follow the Guardsman Pass road to the summit and then start descending down the mountain. While descending, slow down so you don't pass the next intersection.
11. You will come to an intersection with a street sign on left side. You have the options of: turning a hard left, going back down the mountain towards Midway; continuing straight going up the mountain to Guardsman Pass; or taking a slight left onto a gravel road where there is a yellow gate a few yards away.
12. This is the gate for Camp Cloud Rim.
