

Directions to Trefoil Ranch

Trefoil Ranch is located near Provo, UT-approximately one hour from downtown Salt Lake City.


FROM SALT LAKE CITY

- 1. Take I-15 south to Exit 272 (800 N/UT-52); the Provo Canyon/Sundance exit.
- 2. Turn left (East) onto State Highway 52 (800 North).
- 3. After about 3.5 miles, you'll take the (left lane) ramp onto US 189 (E Provo Canyon Road).
- 4. Stay on 189, past Bridal Veil Falls, to Vivian Park (watch for the sign; it's about 5.5 miles from the mouth of the canyon)
- 5. Turn right into Vivian Park.* Cross the bridge in the park and veer to the left at the South Fork sign.
- 6. Continue up the South Fork road for approximately five miles to the Trefoil Ranch gate at the end of the road (you will pass a "Dead End" sign—keep going).

*If you reach the tunnel, you have gone past Vivian Park.

FROM CAMP CLOUD RIM

- 1. Drive towards Park City on Marsac—over the summit and down the mountain—to the second roundabout.
- 2. Go around the roundabout and take the second right (Deer Valley Dr.).
- 3. From Deer Valley Drive, turn right on Bonanza.
- 4. Turn right on Kearns.
- 5. Turn right to merge onto HWY 40 towards Heber.
- 6. Stay on Highway 40 for about 14 miles; turn right at US-189.
- 7. Stay on US-189 for about 16 miles. After you go through the tunnel, watch for the sign for Vivian Park.
- 8. Turn left into Vivian Park. Cross the bridge in the park and veer to the left at the South Fork sign.
- 9. Continue up the South Fork road for approximately five miles to the Trefoil Ranch gate at the end of the road (you will pass a "Dead End" sign—keep going).



Driving Safety

- The speed limit in camp and in the parking lot is 10 mph.
- The 4.5 mile-long drive from Vivian Park to camp is a narrow paved road. Please drive with care and watch for oncoming traffic and bicyclists, runners, and animals.
- Passengers need to be seated at all times. Seatbelts MUST be worn at all times. Drivers need to watch for pedestrian traffic in the parking lot.
