
Minicamp: Payment Acknowledgment, Cell Phones, Photo/Media

For:

MINICAMP PAYMENT OPTIONS

Payment Option 1

Pay in full by credit card at the time of registration. Note: This payment cannot be retro-activated; meaning you cannot turn around and submit Activity Credits as a camp payment and be refunded that amount on your credit card.

OR

Payment Option 2

First Step:

Pay the non-refundable, non-transferable deposit* by credit card for each program, due at the time of registration. Note: This deposit on your credit card is final and will not be refunded in exchange for Activity Credits.

*Deposits are as follows:

Program Fee = Deposit

\$0-\$19 = No deposit

\$20-\$49 = \$10 deposit

\$50-\$99 = \$20 deposit

\$100-\$149 = \$30 deposit

\$150-\$199 = \$40 deposit

\$200+ = \$50 deposit

FAMILY CAMP = Lodging fee paid during initial registration

REMAINING BALANCES ARE DUE IN FULL 14 DAYS PRIOR TO THE PROGRAM START DATE.

Second Step:

Pay balances (partial or in full) by credit card through your family's UltraCamp account. Note: These credit card payments are final and will not be refunded in exchange for Activity Credits at a later date.

Pay balances (partial or in full) with Activity Credits and/or check by submitting payment, along with a registration receipt, through mail or in-person to a Girl Scouts of Utah's office.

MINICAMP PROGRAM CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

For:

All deposits* are non-refundable and non-transferable to other individuals or other camp programs for the same individual. The remainder of the camp fee (less the deposit) will be refunded if:

- (1) GSU receives a written notification of the cancellation at least 14 days prior to camp program start date,
- (2) individual leaves camp program due to illness or injury and GSU receives a written request for a refund within two weeks after the individual returns home,
- (3) refund will be pro-rated on per diem basis,
- (4) individual cannot attend camp program because they become ill or injured and GSU receives a written request for a refund, with a physician's note, within one week after scheduled camp program, or
- (5) GSU cancels the camp program and alternative programs were offered, but the individual chose to not select an alternative program.

No refunds if an individual returns home due to homesickness, misconduct, parent/guardian request, and/or any other circumstance.

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ACTIVITY SCHOLARSHIPS:

This program provides assistance for individual girl members who are registered Girl Scouts and wish to attend Girl Scouts of Utah-sponsored camps or programs, but are unable, due to financial restraints. This program is not a reward, nor is it a way to repay volunteer work a caregiver might have done for Girl Scouts. The decision to grant an activity scholarship, and the amount, is based on information provided on the application form. All information is confidential and discussed only by those responsible for allocating money.

Applications for an activity scholarship may be submitted after the completion of the initial registration and the non-refundable, non-transferable deposit is paid. Scholarship applications are due 21 days prior to the program start date. Scholarship awards will be applied to camp balances once awarded. Awards are based on funding available at that time.

The Activity Scholarship form can be found in the Document Center under Additional Options on the Navigation Toolbar in your family's UltraCamp account.

CELL PHONE POLICY

Minors are not allowed to have cell phones with them during their stay at camp. They cannot be used for phone calls, social media, text messaging, cameras, internet, etc. Any cell phone brought to camp will be secured in the camp office until your child returns home. Campers are not allowed to use the camp phone. However, you are welcome to contact the Camp Director at any time to check on how your child is doing.

Adults attending camp may bring a cell phone; however, service is not reliable on camp property. We ask that phones not be used in the presence of minors.

PHOTO/MEDIA RELEASE

By registering for a camp program, you give permission for photographs, video, audiotape, and artist renditions to be taken of the individual registered while involved in camp programs. You allow Girl Scouts of Utah to release said images for the promotion and publicity of Girl Scouting.

DISCLAIMER

For:

Girl Scouts of Utah plans quality programs for camp with the health, safety, and well-being of individuals as our first priority. Some sessions may be altered or cancelled due to weather, fire, natural disaster, staffing concerns, or low registration numbers. The Camp Director may determine whether an individual is competent to participate in any activity; and if necessary, transfer them to another program. When necessary, individuals will participate in alternate activities. No alternation or refunds will be issued if changes are made to activities due to weather, fire, or natural disaster. If a session is canceled due to low registration numbers, individuals will be given the opportunity to select another program. individuals are expected to follow the Girl Scout Promise and Law. If an individual is unable to follow camp guidelines, damages property or becomes a danger to themselves or others, the Camp Director will work one-on-one with them and/or may choose to send them home.
