



Summer Camp: Payment Acknowledgment, Cell Phones,

For:

CAMP PAYMENT OPTIONS (Registering prior to May 20, 2020)

Payment Option 1

Pay in full by credit card at the time of registration. Note: This payment cannot be retro-activated; meaning you cannot turn around and submit Activity Credits as a camp payment and be refunded that amount on your credit card.

OR

Payment Option 2

First Step:

Pay the \$50 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit* by credit card for each program, due at the time of registration. Note: This deposit on your credit card is final and will not be refunded in exchange for Activity Credits.

REMAINING BALANCES ARE DUE BY MAY 20, 2020.
UNPAID BALANCES AFTER MAY 20, 2020 WILL RESULT IN CANCELLATION OF PROGRAM REGISTRATION.

Second Step:

Pay balances (partial or in full) by credit card through your family's UltraCamp account. Note: These credit card payments are final and will not be refunded in exchange for Activity Credits at a later date.

Pay balances (partial or in full) with Activity Credits and/or check by submitting payment, along with a registration receipt, through mail or in-person to a Girl Scouts of Utah's office.

CAMP PAYMENT OPTIONS (Registering after May 20, 2020)

Pay in full by credit card at the time of registration.

Activity Credits can be applied retroactively by submitting Activity Credits, along with a registration receipt, through mail or in-person to a Girl Scouts of Utah's location.

ACTIVITY CREDITS MUST BE RECEIVED WITHIN 10 DAYS OF REGISTERING FOR THE PROGRAM. Those received after the 10 day window will be mailed back to the individual and the payment will remain as is on the credit card.

Upon receiving Activity Credits, a refund will be issued on your credit card.

RESIDENT CAMP PROGRAM CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

For:

The \$50 deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable to other individuals or other camp programs for the same individual. The remainder of the camp fee (less the deposit) will be refunded if:

- (1) GSU receives a written notification of the cancellation at least five weeks prior to camp program,
- (2) individual leaves camp program due to illness or injury and GSU receives a written request for a refund within two weeks after the individual returns home,
- (3) refund will be pro-rated on per diem basis,
- (4) camper cannot attend camp program because they becomes ill or injured and GSU receives a written request for a refund, with a physician's note, within one week after scheduled camp program, or
- (5) GSU cancels the camp program and alternative programs were offered, but the individual chose to not select an alternative program.

No refunds if an individual returns home due to homesickness, misconduct, parent/guardian request, and/or any other circumstance.

ACTIVITY SCHOLARSHIPS

This program provides assistance for individual girl members who are registered Girl Scouts and wish to attend Girl Scouts of Utah-sponsored camps or programs, but are unable, due to financial restraints. This program is not a reward, nor is it a way to repay volunteer work a caregiver might have done for Girl Scouts. The decision to grant an activity scholarship, and the amount, is based on information provided on the application form. All information is confidential and discussed only by those responsible for allocating money.

Applications for an activity scholarship may be submitted after the completion of the initial registration and the non-refundable, non-transferable deposit is paid. Scholarship applications are due April 1. Scholarship awards will be applied to camp balances no later than May 1. All applications received after April 1 will be awarded based on funding available at that time.

The Activity Scholarship form can be found in the Document Center under Additional Options on the Navigation Toolbar in your family's UltraCamp account.

CELL PHONE POLICY

Minors are not allowed to have cell phones with them during their stay at camp. They cannot be used for phone calls, social media, text messaging, cameras, internet, etc. Any cell phone brought to camp will be secured in the camp office until your child returns home. Campers are not allowed to use the camp phone. However, you are welcome to contact the Camp Director at any time to check on how your child is doing.

PHOTO/MEDIA RELEASE

By registering for a camp program, you give permission for photographs, video, audiotape, and artist renditions to be taken of the individual registered while involved in camp programs. You allow Girl Scouts of Utah to release said images for the promotion and publicity of Girl Scouting.

DISCLAIMER

Girl Scouts of Utah plans quality programs for camp with the health, safety, and well-being of individuals as our first priority. Some sessions may be altered or cancelled due to weather, fire, natural disaster, staffing concerns, or low registration numbers. The Camp Director may determine whether an individual is competent to participate in any activity; and if necessary, transfer them to another program. When necessary, individuals will participate in alternate activities. No alternation or refunds will be issued if changes are made to activities due to weather, fire, or natural disaster. If a session is canceled due to low registration numbers, individuals will be given the opportunity to select another program. Individuals are expected to follow the Girl Scout Promise and Law. If an individual is unable to follow camp guidelines, damages property or becomes a danger to themselves or others, the Camp Director will work one-on-one with them and/or may choose to send them home.
