
Resident Camp 2021: Acknowledgement Form

For:

CAMP PAYMENTS

Registering prior to May 20, 2021

Option 1:

Pay in full by credit card at the time of registration. Note: This payment cannot be retro-activated; meaning you cannot turn around and submit Activity Credits as a camp payment and be refunded that amount on your credit card.

Option 2:

Pay the \$50 non-refundable deposit by credit card for each program, due at the time of registration. Note: This deposit on your credit card is final and will not be refunded in exchange for Activity Credits.

Pay balances (partial or in full) by credit card through your family's UltraCamp account. Note: These credit card payments are final and will not be refunded in exchange for Activity Credits at a later date.

Pay balances (partial or in full) with Activity Credits and/or check by submitting payment, along with a registration receipt, through mail or in-person to a Girl Scouts of Utah's office.

REMAINING BALANCES ARE DUE BY MAY 20, 2021.

UNPAID BALANCES AFTER MAY 20, 2021 WILL RESULT IN CANCELLATION OF PROGRAM REGISTRATION.

Registering on or after May 20, 2021

Pay in full by credit card at the time of registration.

Activity Credits can be applied retroactively by submitting Activity Credits, along with a registration receipt, through mail or in-person to a Girl Scouts of Utah's location.

ACTIVITY CREDITS MUST BE RECEIVED WITHIN 10 DAYS OF REGISTERING FOR THE PROGRAM. Those received after the 10 day window will be mailed back to the individual and the payment will remain as is on the credit card.

Upon receiving Activity Credits, a refund will be issued on your credit card.

Activity Scholarships

This program provides assistance for individual girl members who are registered Girl Scouts and wish to attend Girl Scouts of Utah-sponsored camps or programs, but are unable, due to financial restraints. This program is not a reward, nor is it a way to repay volunteer work a caregiver might have done in Girl Scouting. The decision to grant an activity scholarship, and the amount, is based on information provided on the application form. All information is confidential and discussed only by those responsible for allocating money.

Applications for an activity scholarship may be submitted after the completion of the initial registration and a \$50 non-refundable deposit is paid. Scholarship applications are due April 1. Scholarship awards will be applied to camp balances no later than May 1. All applications received after April 1 will be awarded based on funding available at that time.

Resident Camp Program Cancellation and Refund Policy

The \$50 deposit is non-refundable. The remainder of the camp fee (\$50 deposit excluded) will be refunded if:

- (1) GSU receives a written (email) notification of the cancellation at least five weeks prior to the camp program.
- (2) Camper leaves the camp program due to illness or injury and GSU receives a written (email) request for a refund within two weeks after camper returns home. Refund will be pro-rated on per-diem basis.
- (3) Camper cannot attend the camp program because she becomes ill or injured and GSU receives a written (email) request for a refund, with a physician's note, within one week after scheduled camp program.
- (4) GSU cancels the camp program and alternative programs were offered, but you choose to not select an alternative program.

No refunds will be provided if a girl returns home due to homesickness, misconduct, parent/guardian request, and/or any other circumstance.

If changes become necessary due to the impact of COVID-19, we will offer alternate program options or the option to choose a full refund (including the deposit).

ITEMS TO NOTE

Camp Buddies

Camp Buddy If your camper wants to go to camp with a buddy, both campers must register for the same session. When completing your camper's forms after registration, there will be a place to list your camper's buddy. Camp buddies can be updated if needed.

Cell Phone Policy

Minors are not allowed to have cell phones with them during their stay at camp. They cannot be used for phone calls, social media, text messaging, cameras, internet, etc. Any cell phone brought to camp will be secured in the camp office until your child returns home. Campers are not allowed to use the camp phone. However, you are welcome to contact the Camp Director at any time to check on how your child is doing.

Photo/Media Release

By registering for a camp program, you give permission for photographs, video, audiotape, and artist renditions to be taken of the individual registered while involved in camp programs. You allow Girl Scouts of Utah to release said images for the promotion and publicity of Girl Scouting.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Girl Scouts of Utah plans quality programs with the health, safety, and well-being of campers as our first priority. Sessions may be altered or canceled due to weather, fire, natural disaster, staffing challenges, or low registration numbers. If a session is canceled due to low registration numbers, campers will be given the opportunity to select another program. No refunds will be issued if changes are made to activities due to weather, fire, or natural disaster. However, if changes become necessary due to the impact of COVID-19, we will offer alternate program options or the option to choose a full refund. The Camp Director may determine whether a girl is competent to participate in any activity, and, if necessary, transfer her to another program. When necessary, campers will participate in alternate activities. Campers are expected to follow the Girl Scout Promise and Law. If a camper is unable to follow camp guidelines, damages property, or becomes a danger to themselves or others, the Camp Director will work with the camper and may elect to send them home.
