

Ironwood Campground Policies

<u>Check-in time: 3:00 pm</u> Quiet time: 10:30 pm <u>Check-out time: 1:00 pm</u>

- Each campsite accommodates one camping unit.
- No more than 8 people per campsite.
- Campsites include electricity, a picnic table and campfire pit.
- Community fresh water spigots are available and hoses must be removed after use.
- Sewage dump stations are available for sites without full hookups.
- Public restrooms are available in the Founder's Lodge building.
- Child supervision is required at all times.
- Pets must be leashed at all times and are not allowed in any buildings, or the horse pastures. Please keep pets quiet and clean up waste.
- Please refrain from smoking in or near buildings.
- NO ALCOHOL is allowed on Ironwood property.
- NO WEAPONS of any kind are allowed on Ironwood property.
- NO FIREWORKS are allowed on Ironwood property.
- NO MOTORIZED 2-, 3-, or 4-wheel recreational vehicles are allowed unless required for disability.
- Christian principals are expected in speech, conduct, dress and activities. Modest swimsuits or cover-ups required.
- In case of a tornado or bad weather, the dorm area beneath the Founder's Lodge is a safe location.
- Seasonal Campers may camp Thursday through Sunday, Memorial Day through Labor Day.
- Trail rides must be reserved ahead of time from our website: Ironwoodsprings.com. The charge is \$30/person for a 1-hour ride. Riders must be at least 8 years of age and wear closed-toed shoes. Please do not enter the horse pasture at any time; restrooms at arena are closed as well.
- Campfires should be no higher than three (3) feet and contained in designated fire rings.

Campfire wood:

Guests may not bring firewood in from off-site location. Firewood must be purchased by phone before your arrival for \$5/bucket or \$20/wheelbarrow and delivered to your campsite in advance.



COVID-19-Related Campground Policies

- We are *NOT* a quarantine site. Anyone in your family who is experiencing COVID 19 symptoms should stay home. Symptoms include:
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fever
 - Chills
 - Muscle Pain
 - Sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell
- Campsites must consist of only one family (single household). No guests outside of your household are allowed.
- RV sites will be placed no less than 50' apart; campers are encouraged to stay within your site.
- Guests must call the office to schedule a campsite which will be available Thursday through Sunday.
- Founder's Lodge bathrooms (including showers) are open. All other bathrooms are closed. Guests must maintain physical distancing (outside of your household) within bathrooms.
- Community fresh water spigots and sewage stations are available. Hand sanitizer stations will be available at all of the shared locations.
- Shared campfires are allowed if six foot physical distancing guidelines are maintained and less than ten people are gathered.
- Masks are not required, but are recommended if in close proximity to non-household guest.
- These are some of the activities our guests can enjoy while at Ironwood Springs.
 - Swimming pool (see next page for swimming pool rules)
 - Minigolf (hand sanitizer is provided for use before and after mini-golf)
 - Walking trails
 - Playgrounds
 - Fishing
 - Disc Golf, volleyball, tennis and basketball courts will be available to use if you bring your own equipment.

Swimming Pool Rules:

- No more than 34 people are allowed within the pool area (inside the fence) in order to maintain our 50% capacity limit. Please limit your time at the pool to an hour or less if other guests are waiting.
- 6 foot physical distancing (outside of household) must be maintain in the pool and in the pool area.
- All youth should be accompanied by at least one adult to ensure safety and distancing guidelines are observed.
- All pool furniture has been removed from pool area. Guests should bring their own chairs.
- No pool toys are provided for common use. Pool toys should not be shared between households.
- As usual, guests should shower before entering pool.
