As Park Camp's 86th season prepares to begin, we look forward to having your child in our program. We are eagerly anticipating another fun-filled, safe, and exciting Summer Camp. We have been planning and preparing for lots of new theme days and wonderful events. Enthusiasm is high and our staff cannot wait to get started!

In order to provide a rewarding summer for all, please carefully review the enclosed information to facilitate and enhance our line of communication.

Arrival at Camp

Camp begins at 9:00 am. Campers may begin to arrive between 8:45 and 9:00am unless extended day arrangements have been made.

- Extended day hours are 7:30 am to 9:00 am and 3:45 - 5:30 pm in the Camp Dining Hall.
- A group location map and extended day is enclosed in this packet to assist you in finding where drop off and pickup locations are found by group. Each group will have a sign and grade level posted.
- Camp staff will assist your child from your car and walk them to your group counselor.
- If you prefer to walk your child to their group, please park in the Rich Center Parking Lot off of Harlem Road and walk them up to their group counselor.

If you need to speak with the Camp secretary, a camp administrator, or Health Office nurse please park in the Rich Center parking lot or behind the Dining Hall located on the map outside of the traffic flow.

Departure from Camp

Camper Pickup will progress in the same pattern around the circle in two lanes. By 3:40 pm, the campus will be open for traffic flow with the assistance of counselors. At parent pickup, counselors will follow your pick-up list provided with your registration.

Any modifications for pickup must be made in the camp office with the camp secretary. Safety is our priority every day at Park Camp. You may be asked to show a photo ID to the group counselor until the Camp staff recognizes you (This is especially for the younger campers) Your cooperation is greatly appreciated in this matter. The Amherst Police have been hired to assist with pm traffic flow exiting at Harlem Road daily.

The Park Summer Camp will follow all Erie County Health Department requirements and policies. If any of our policies need to be modified throughout the season, you will be contacted via email as soon as possible.

Camp Necessities

Bring to Camp daily:

- Bathing Suit and towel (Pre K and K bring water shoes)
- Spray on sunscreen
- Refillable water bottle
- Change of clothes (optional)
- Rain jacket for rainy days

All items must be clearly labeled with the camper's name and carried in a sturdy bag or backpack. **WE CANNOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.** A Lost and Found table will be located in the lobby outside the Health Office.

Meet and Greet for parents and campers is Wednesday, June 29 at 11 am to noon in the Dining Hall. Meet the Camp Administration and your child's Group Counselors. A tour will be offered immediately following the informal meeting.

Each camper will receive a complimentary t-shirt with the camp logo during your child's first week of camp.
