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


DIVERSE & EXPERIENCED STAFF

Summer enrichment is one of the most important investments that a parent will make for their child. With an average cost of \$5 per hour your child will receive the highest caliber experience that includes academic enrichment, field trips, sports, electives and so much more.







The enrichment core will prepare our emerging seventh and eighth grade campers for the greater demands of high school. The language arts curriculum introduces socially-relevant concepts from a variety of subject areas including history/social studies and science. Writing exercises will give this group practice of making arguments, narratives and demonstrating understanding of a topic. STEM themes in the areas of Forensic Science, Aerospace Engineering, and Robotics will cultivate, equip, and stimulate our campers during the project segments. We will also examine the career paths that are often taken to be successful in these fields.

7th graders will also learn about content related to the US History Tour, including the Revolutionary War, the Constitution, Slavery, Reconstruction, Industrial Revolution, the Civil Rights era and the Space Age. 8th graders will learn about Canadian French culture and cuisine as part of their end of camp tour to Canada.



ENTREPRENEURSHIP

During this program segment, 5th-8th grade campers will learn how to take an idea and develop it into a business. Projects are collaborative, and focus on developing skills in financial literacy, critical thinking and communication. The program introduces advanced business tenets including organizational structure, supply chain and financial markets. Campers will also experience the business cycle, as they go from the planning to market in a competitive team format.

ETIQUETTE LESSONS

Our etiquette lessons-taught daily-offer grade-appropriate instruction in soft skills necessary to make lasting impressions and be successful in the classroom and workplace. Lessons include understanding body language, manners outside of the home, digital diplomacy and table manners.

MATH LAB

This extra academic course, designed for our 5th & 6th grade students, further develops math skills as they prepare to encounter more complicated curriculum in junior high school.

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Our basketball program, available to students across all grades, focuses on fundamentals and becoming a complete player.

Campers practice these skills through individual warm ups and drills, as well as scrimmages and intra-camp competitive games.

GOLF

Our golf program is divided into two groups: Novice and Advanced. The Novice group focuses on the basics of golf: safety, etiquette, scoring through fun games, drills, and some course play. The Advanced group, comprised of intermediate to experienced junior golfers, will focus on golf fitness, short game refinement, tournament preparation, and course play.

MODERN DANCE

This activity is divided into two groups: Beginner and Intermediate. Technical skills will be taught according to the dancers' placement. Students can also expect instruction in the history of modern dance, physical wellness and body mechanics.

SOCCER

Our soccer programming focuses on technical aspects of the game, including dribbling, passing and finishing. We also provide goalkeeper-specific training. Players are also challenged through a combination of small-sided and full team matches.

SWIMMING

Swimming is available to Wiz Kids as a Core Program option for our 5th-8th grade grouping. In addition to swim instruction, swimmers will be introduced to a new activity every week, including: Jr Lifeguard, Water Volleyball, Water Frisbee, Water Archery Tag, and Splashball. At the end of the session, a swim meet will be held on Championship Friday. Our 1st-4th grader groupings will swim on Field Trip Fridays.



TAE KWON DO

Campers enrolled in Tae Kwon Do will develop basic martial arts skills that focus on proper breathing, mental focus, and self-discipline. For more advanced students, this course provides an opportunity to prepare for promotion by honing their techniques.

TENNIS

The tennis program places a special emphasis on player development, and is one of our most popular activities. Beginners focus on proper form, stroke, court position and movement. Advanced players work on stroke refinement and tournament readiness, which students further develop through weekly match play. Our staff is led by USPTA certified professionals, who have experience coaching players across all skill levels.

TRACK & FIELD

Through the multiple disciplines of sprinting, hurdling, jumping, throwing, and pole vaulting, campers learn about speed and power development, running and field mechanics, warm-up routines, plyometrics, and more! Campers have opportunities to participate in internal and external meets throughout the summer.

TUMBLING

This activity, for campers in 1st-4th grade, is geared toward body control. Campers will focus on building agility and flexibility, which supports athletic development for all sports!

VOLLEYBALL

Our volleyball program is carefully designed to advance campers' skills in all volleyball fundamentals, including serving, setting, passing, attacking, blocking, and digging. Campers will develop their skills through a combination of drills and team play.



FIELD TRIPS & ON CAMPUS EXPLORATION

On most Fridays, we will take the campers on a variety of field trip adventures designed to provide them with fun, enriching, entertaining and diverse experiences. Locations are selected based on the age and range from curriculum inspired trips like Blackberry Farms and Sci-Tech Museum to high energy escapades to Pelican Harbor and Laser Quest. Occasionally, we will even bring to the campus external programs that are uniquely customized for our groups, like culinary expeditions or mock-court trial simulations. Our 1st-4th grader groupings will also swim on Field Trip Fridays.

SPECIAL DAYS

Throughout the camp season we occasionally have activities that alter the typical schedules. There will be fun days, specialty field trips for select activity groups and movie presentations. Camp attendees will also have the opportunity to participate in change of pace sporting games, and cultural art projects. Competitions and collaborative activities will also take place between participants at our Chicago and Suburban locations, including a service project. As always the summer will conclude with two annual marquee events, Championship Friday and camp awards banquet.

NUTRITION

Health consciousness is an important theme for Wiz Kids programs. As such, we exclusively provide the freshest organic and natural foods to camp participants during morning and afternoon snack times.



CAMP UNIVERSITY

The program is designed as an individualized summer experiences for students entering grades 9-12. The offerings include intense college entrance exam preparation, career exploration courses, and a college tour series. We also offer elite off-season training activities in various athletic programs.

Except for our College Tour series, which takes place on Fridays, all classes occur in the afternoon to accommodate the schedules of students who are participating in summer school.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Culinary Arts Lab fee: 7th & 8th graders enrolled in Culinary Arts will be assessed a \$150 laboratory consumable fee per activity block.

Program change fees: A \$75 program change fee will apply for campers who switch core activity or elective options <u>after</u> the start of the camp season.

Deposits: A specified non-refundable fee will be collected at the time of registration. Balances for all camp programs must be paid in full by May 31, 2020 in order to complete enrollment. We cannot guarantee placement in camp if balances are outstanding after that date. Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable to other Wiz Kids Camps programs.

- A \$50 or \$75 non-refundable deposit will be required during early registration
- A \$250 non-refundable deposit will be required during general registration.

Trip Fee Refund Policy: All cancellations for 7th or 8th grade trips must be in writing and submitted to Wiz Kids Camps, LLC. If a cancellation occurs anytime prior to April 1, 2020, 100% of trip related payments will be returned. If cancellation occurs anytime between April 1, 2020 and May 31, 2020, 50% of paid trip fees will be withheld. After May 31, 2020, 100% of all paid trip fees will be withheld.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Extended Care and Lunch Refund Policy: All cancellations must be in writing and submitted to Wiz Kids Camps, LLC. Refunds for extended care or lunch are fully refundable up until 72-hours prior to the start of the upcoming camp week for which these program options were originally purchased. Fees will be withheld for cancellations that are made within or after the 72-hour time window.

Camp Tuition and Activity/Elective Refund Policy: All cancellations must be in writing and submitted to Wiz Kids Camps, LLC. If a cancellation occurs anytime prior to April 1, 2020, 100% of tuition and/or activity/elective related payments (less the non-refundable fee) will be returned. If cancellation occurs anytime between April 1, 2020 and May 1, 2020, 40% of camp fees will be withheld. After May 1, 2020, 100% of all paid tuition related camp fees will be withheld.

Late Payments: Tuition accounts with outstanding balances after May 20, 2020 will be assessed a \$100 convenience fee. **No exceptions.**

Outstanding balances: All balances must be settled prior to the start of the camp season. Campers will not be eligible to attend until outstanding tuition obligations have been closed. **No exceptions.**
