Code of Conduct

These regulations have been created for your safety and welfare. Any student not complying with the guidelines set below should expect a disciplinary reaction. Discipline may range from a simple reprimand to being sent home by plane at the expense of parents/guardians.

1. With exception of the allowance of the use of cell phones and electronic items, all Wiz Kids Sports Camps rules of conduct apply to this trip.
2. Act in a manner that will leave every person we have contact with a good impression. We are representing our camp, community and state on this tour.
3. All students/chaperones will attend all functions and tours in which we are scheduled.
4. **No students will leave their room after curfew.**
5. Campers are prohibited from entering rooms of fellow campers of the opposite sex.
6. Respect other hotel guests at all times.
7. You must be with at least 2 other students at all times during free time in the hotel. **Do not go anywhere by yourself!!!!**
8. Always be on time. If you are late, the whole group is late. This may jeopardize our scheduled events and may result in you missing part of the trip itinerary.
9. Be courteous to chaperones, airline/airport staff, activity staff, drivers, etc. Absolutely no disrespect will be tolerated.
10. Do not talk with strangers on the street.
11. You will be approached by people on the street asking for various things; money, directions, offering literature, please do not engage in a conversation with these people. Keep walking. This is not a place to be nice or naive. There are plenty of police officers available to assist people who need help.
12. Stay with our group. Do not venture away from the group you are with and it is your responsibility to keep up.
13. Parents may consider buying a credit/debit card (with a fixed amount on it) for their child.

Hotel Instructions

1. Upon arriving at the hotel, check your room for any damage or malfunctioning equipment and report any problems to your chaperone.
2. The occupants of the room will pay for any misuse of or damage to hotel property.
3. Use your cell phones for phone calls. Phones in your rooms cannot be used for long distance calls without a charge.
4. At curfew times, you must be in your room. At this time and after, you will open the door for no one other than a chaperone or hotel official.
5. Be respectful of the other guests. You are responsible to keep your room quiet after curfew. You will be held responsible if a hotel manager calls your room or your director or chaperone's room because of a disturbance.
6. Do not take towels and souvenirs from your room. You will be charged for these items and any other damage to your hotel room.
7. Keep your room locked at all times.
8. Keep all valuables with you at all times.
9. At no time is anyone outside of people on the Wiz Kids trip allowed to enter your room. Do not give out your hotel name or room number to anyone for any reason.
10. Students are not allowed under any circumstances to stay in a staff member's room or a room other than the assigned hotel room.
11. You will not be able to order room service.

Airport/Airline/Bus Conduct

1. Be prompt for any departure; don't keep the whole group waiting.
2. Upon arrival at all stopping places, stay on with the group until instructions are given by chaperones.
3. Food and drink may be consumed while traveling. Waste should be properly disposed of.
4. The transportation personnel are experts in the field. Please treat them with courtesy and respect- keeping in mind their responsibility to get us to and from events on the trip safely. While we are on our flights and on the bus please keep the noise at a conversation level.
5. No stereos are allowed. If you bring a personal music/movie player make sure you have headphones to listen to your music or movie.
