#### **Tuition and Fees**

Tuition fees are on a sliding scale based on the number of weeks of enrollment, and will vary slightly based on the campus location and program selection.

# ENROLLMENT

#### **DEPOSITS:**

A \$75 non-refundable deposit is required to complete the initial registration. Deposits are non- refundable and nontransferable to other Wiz Kids Camps programs.

#### **EXTENDED CARE REFUND POLICY:**

All cancellations must be inwriting and submitted to Wiz Kids Sports Camps, LLC. Refunds for extended care are fully refundable 72-hours prior to the start of the applicable camp week for which this option was originally purchased. Fees will be withheld for cancellations that are made within or after the 72-hour time window.

#### **CAMP TUITION REFUND POLICY:**

All cancellations must be in writing and submitted to Wiz Kids Camps, LLC. If a cancellation occurs anytime prior to April 1, 2023, 100% of tuition and/or activity/ elective related payments (less the nonrefundable fee) will be returned. If cancellation occurs anytime between April 1, 2023 and May 2, 2023, 40% of camp fees will be withheld. After May 2, 2023, 100% of all paid tuition related camp fees will be withheld. Balances for all camp programs must be paid in full by May 28, 2023 in order to complete enrollment. We cannot guarantee placement in camp if balances are outstanding after that date. Late Payments: Tuition accounts with outstanding balances after May 28, 2023 will automatically be assessed a \$50 convenience fee.

#### **BALANCES:**

All balances must be settled prior to the start of the camp season. Campers will not be eligible to attend until outstanding tuition obligations have been met. No exceptions.
