

## **Health Guidelines**

## DAILY CERIFICATION/VERIFICATION

- Each parent must self-certify their child's health prior to the start of each camp day using Crisis Go<sup>™</sup>.
- 2. Each student must bring the QR code to camp daily for clearance. Student will not be admitted to camp without being certified with Crisis Go<sup>™</sup>.
- 3. Wellness checks will be performed upon morning arrival. Any camper with a temperature over 100.0 F will be asked to return home.
- 4. Social distancing will be enforced during camp hours. No students are to be within 3 ft. without a mask while outside. While indoors we will ask campers to wear mask. The mask policy will be enforced with discretion during sporting activities.
- 5. Each camper is responsible for having their own mask. If your child forgets his/her mask, we will provide them with a disposable mask.
- 6. If camper exhibits any of the follow keep camper home:
  - a. Fever 100.0 F or greater
  - b. Persistent cough
  - c. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - d. Chills
  - e. Nasal congestion or runny nose
  - f. New loss of taste or smell
  - g. Sore throat
  - h. Diarrhea
  - i. Nausea or vomiting
  - j. Stomach-ache
  - k. Unusual fatigue
  - I. Headache
  - m. Muscle or body aches
  - n. Any other Covid-19 symptoms per the CDC and IDPH

## SICK CAMPER

1. If a camper arrives at camp sick or becomes sick during the day, a parent/guardian will be contacted to pick up the camper immediately. Due to Covid-19 we will ask that the camper

quarantine for 10-14 days returning on the 11<sup>th</sup> or 15<sup>th</sup> day with no symptoms. Negative results from a physician or state certified COVID-19 test may be provided to clear quarantine. **Campers that have been quarantined will be required to be symptom free to get full clearance to return. The health office will grant final clearances.** 

- 2. Due to Covid-19, you have an hour to pick up a sick camper. Please ensure you have someone reliable on your emergency contact.
- 3. If a camper becomes ill, they will have to wear a mask until picked up.
- 4. Make sure to add medical history for each student. We will use this in determining illness.

## QUARANTINE

- 1. If a camper is sick, they must quarantine for 10 days. During this time, **campers** are not allowed on campus until cleared by the health office.
- 2. Avoiding quarantine: If your child is not feeling keep them home until they are clear of symptoms.
- 3. Campers can be asked to quarantine with or without a fever.
- If the camper or anyone living with the camper has been in contact with someone with Covid-19. You will be asked to quarantine for 14 days. Camper may return on the 15<sup>th</sup> day without symptoms.

\*\*\*Unfortunately we do not have control over Covid-19 cases, if asked to quarantine you will not receive a refund for those days during quarantine or illness.
