Facilities

With over 250 acres of property, SMCC offers all sorts of activities that make camp a fun, amazing time for everyone. The Joy Center contains a gym for basketball, volleyball, and other games; climbing wall and giant swing; game room with foosball, ping pong, etc.; arts & crafts; and more. Outdoors we have a swimming pool, ball fields, sand volleyball court, Ga-Ga Ball arenas, 9 Square in the Air, archery range, 18-hole disc golf course, a lake for fishing and boating, campfire areas, and hiking trails. We also have a High Ropes Tower with double zip lines for older campers and a Low Ropes Course for all ages.

We want to help campers experience the love and grace of God. With this focus, our theme this year is The AmazinGrace. We will use the imagery and concepts of a race around the world to teach campers how amazing God's grace is. Campers will attend nightly chapel services with fun, exciting lessons which include singing, skits, puppets, videos, games, and object lessons to teach the truths of the Bible. Also, campers will participate in small group Bible discussions led by the Cabin Director. On Fridays, we provide an opportunity for campers who have made a profession of faith to be baptized. Parents who do not wish for their child to be baptized here can easily indicate so on the camper application.

DIRECTIONS TO CAMP

For GPS:

The physical address of the Camp is 1129 South Mountain Road, Bostic NC 28018.

From Forest City:

At the intersection of 74 business & Bostic-Sunshine Hwy, take Bostic-Sunshine Hwy for 4.5 miles. At Washburn Store, take Right fork onto Salem Church Road. Go 1.8 miles to crossroads, and Left onto South Mountain Road. Go 1/4 mile to Camp Entrance on the right.

(SMCC sign and red metal gate) Follow this road into camp.

It will lead to a large metal building labeled Joy Center.

REFUND POLICIES

Once a child has arrived and checked in at camp, camp fees will not be refunded if a camper leaves camp early for any reason. We will, however, refund the unspent portion of the camper's canteen funds.

If a camper has been granted a scholarship for camp and does not show up for camp by 4:00 pm (and does not call to cancel), that camper forfeits their scholarship and will not be awarded a scholarship the following year.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How long does summer camp last?

A: SMCC offers six, one-week camp sessions during June-August. Campers stay from 3:00 pm Sunday unti 6:00 pm Friday.

Q: What is the age requirement?

A: Camp is for youth ages 7-15. All ages can come each week.

Q: How many campers are in each cabin?

A: Cabin groups consist of 6-8 campers. All cabin groups are assigned to a trained Cabin Director.

Q: What is the cost for a week of camp?

A: Full cost is \$205. This includes 5 nights lodging, 16 meals, and all activities. Financial assistance is available for those who cannot pay the full amount.

Q: How do I sign up for camp?

A: Camper registration is now online at SouthMountainChristianCamp.org. If you are unable to sign up online, you can download a paper form on the website or call the camp office at 828-245-3322 to request one.

Q: How can I apply for financial assistance?

A: The financial aid forms are included in the camper application process online. All information is kept confidential. Paper applications also include the fianancial aid forms.
