

Driving Directions

Coming from East (from Asheville-25 miles):

- From I-40, take exit 27 onto US 19-23.
- Drive 3-4 miles.
- Do not take exit 104 -- it is easy to get lost.
- Take exit 103 and drive about 1 mile until you see the Lake Junaluska Conference and Retreat Center front entrance on the right.
- Bear right and follow the main road to the Bethea Welcome Center.

Coming from West (from Knoxville- 92 miles):

- From I-40, take exit 20 toward "Lake Junaluska, Maggie Valley".
- Bear right on the ramp.
- Drive 7 miles until you come to the stop light.
- Turn left at the light and drive 3 more miles, and pass through 1 traffic light.
- The Lake Junaluska Conference and Retreat Center front entrance will be on your left shortly after passing through the traffic light
- Turn left and follow the main road to the Bethea Welcome Center.

Coming from Atlanta- 172 miles from Midtown:

- Take I-85 North to I-985 North.
- At Gainesville, GA take 365 North to 441 North into NC.
- Just past Dillsboro, NC, 441 merges with US 74 which will turn into 23/74.
- Take Hwy 23/74 North Lake Junaluska/Maggie Valley Exit (102-B).
- Travel two miles then turn right on US 19. The entrance to Lake Junaluska is approximately ¼ mile on left.
- Turn left and follow the main road to the Bethea Welcome Center.
