



## Family Camping

**Rules, Regulations and Guidelines** - Please read all of these guidelines and be sure to share them with your family.

1. Quiet hours are 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
2. NO alcohol, illegal or illicit drugs, no tobacco products including vaping is allowed on the property.
3. Please refrain from bringing gum, sunflower seeds in the shell, or liquids containing red food dye into buildings.
4. Care should be taken when using craft paint or glue indoors. Glue or paint on tables, carpets or walls will result in deductions from security deposits.
5. The use of candles indoors is strictly prohibited.
6. No pets allowed on the property or in buildings.
7. No firearms, bladed weapons or explosives are allowed on the property.
8. Stay on designated walking paths and roads.
9. Youth (age 17 and younger) must be supervised by an adult at all times.
10. All activity areas (except ball fields and courts), equipment and buildings are not to be used without prior arrangements and approval from Rivercrest staff.
11. Shoes must be worn at all times when outdoors.
12. All of Camp Rivercrest's ATVs and golf carts are to be used only by authorized Rivercrest staff. ATVs may not be brought into camp. Golf carts brought into camp must be approved by Camp Director prior to your retreat.

### Parking

1. Parking is allowed in large parking lot/field area as designated.
2. Please keep vehicles off paths and trails.
3. Vehicles may only unload or pick up by the cabins and River Lodges. An exception is made for those with handicapped placards.
4. All roads need to be clear of obstruction so emergency vehicles can approach building entrances.
5. Vehicle owners are responsible for all valuables left in the vehicle overnight.

### Check out procedures

1. Check each room to make sure no personal items are left behind.
2. Put all trash in waste baskets or dumpsters.
3. Clean up any messes on counters, on or under beds, floors, or walls.
4. Turn off the lights and gas fireplaces.
5. Check out with your host.
