Another camping year is upon us and as seasonal renters at Pugwash I am sure you are looking forward to visiting and enjoying the campground facilities and your many Maritime friends. We are pleased to let you know that the new camping season for 2022 is May 15 to Oct. 15. I realize you may have read much of what follows; however, I encourage you to go through it again as a reminder of some of the regulations we ask you to abide by.

**Summer Camp Program (June 26 thru August 7)** - While you may choose the dates you desire to be at the camp, it is important to realize that there may be a summer camp program going on at the same time. We request that you stay on the sidelines and not become involved or be present at the summer camp events unless express permission is granted to you by the Camp Director. **Have you submitted your Vulnerable Sector Background Check (VSC)?** A letter is enclosed that may be used to assist in the cost of obtaining these documents.

**Sabbath** - While on the campgrounds, you will be pleased to know you are welcome to attend the Pugwash SDA Church program. Sabbath school is at 9:15 am and divine worship is at 11:00 am. The summer camp and seasonal camping are two different programs. Seasonal campers are urged not to invite themselves to the summer camp program. They may request permission to attend specific events on Sabbath from the Camp Director however, permission may be refused.

**Sabbath Activities** - The campground is dedicated to God, to bring Him glory, and for the spiritual renewal to members and friends. Activities on the Sabbath are to be consistent with the principle that this is God's Holy Day and not my holiday. Enjoy the activities in harmony with Christ-centered activities and avoid a holiday atmosphere. In the spirit of the Sabbath, you are asked to refrain from swimming during its hours.

**Meals at the Cafeteria** - If you desire to eat the occasional meal at the cafeteria, please speak to the Camp Director. The meals for this year are \$11.00 for breakfast and \$14.00 for lunch and supper. Children, under 6 years, will be charged \$7.00 per meal.

**Responsibility for Safety** - The safety and security of our children is the responsibility of parents/guardians. It is not the responsibility of the camp staff to care for the children of seasonal campers. We encourage you to bring your own first aid supplies for your personal use; as the first aid attendant and supplies are for the summer camp program use specifically.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding during the camping season. We look forward to sharing the camp grounds with everyone and hope you have a joyful and safe camping season.
